

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL AND COMPETITION ENTRY FORM 2018

Please complete the form and bring it to the meeting with your cheque made payable to CATERHAM BOWLING CLUB. This hopefully will avoid a long queue forming! If you are unable to attend please send your forms and cheque to our Treasurer Jan Burton at 32 Asprey Court, Stafford Road, Caterham CR3 6JX with a SAE no later than 31st March. Forms arriving after this date may result in you being excluded from competitions.

A pre-season Social meeting, chiefly for the purpose of collecting subscriptions and competition fees, will take place in the Club house on Thursday 15th March 2018 from 5.00 pm. The Bar will be open & tea/coffee available.

For all of us, competitive play improves skill and confidence and you are encouraged to support the Club as much as you can in this activity.

MENS

- If you are a new member who has not played bowls before, then you may wish to enter only the singles competitions, especially the Junior Singles (known as the Honey Cup) until you have gained experience.
- Remember too that the challenger (the top name in the pair of names on the competition sheet) is normally required to arrange a marker.

LADIES

- Club Competitions are open to ALL members and ALL members are encouraged to enter.
- If you are a comparatively new bowler, you will enjoy the Junior Championship with its limited opposition from experienced players.
- You will also probably enjoy the Handicap Singles, the 100-up and the Ladies 2 Wood Drawn Pairs.

• Please remember that if you enter any singles competition, you are expected to do your share of the marking of other matches in order to facilitate the running of that competition. Marking is quite simple, and instructions are posted in the clubhouse, and if you want further advice on what is involved our coaches will be happy to give guidance.

It is a condition of membership that all full members undertake some duty to help with the running of the Club under one of the headings below.

Cleaning duty involves being part of a team responsible for cleaning on a particular day each week (Monday, Wednesday or Friday). Dependent on the number in the team, your presence may only be required every 2 or 3 weeks.

Catering duty involves three or four members laying up tables, setting out the meal and making and serving tea to the teams. The food is already provided and there is little or no cooking, washing up or clearing away involved. You would normally be expect to do this three or four times during the season.

Bar duty requires serving behind the bar for roughly one evening per fortnight. You are also responsible for locking up at the end of the evening. Help is usually available if it becomes very busy. If you volunteer for this important task, full training will be given.

Please indicate on the form your preference for duties – put “1” beside your first preference and “2” beside your second. We will do our best to accommodate everybody’s preferences, but you will appreciate that we may have to even out the demand.

PRE-SEASON CLUB PREPARATION

Volunteers are needed to help furnish the Green and prepare the Clubhouse. The date is yet to be confirmed since it will be dependent upon the greenkeeper being satisfied that the condition of the grass is suitable. All things being equal, the date should be Thursday 12th April 10:00 am, so please provisionally keep this date and time clear in your diaries if possible. Thank you.
